On April 26, 2014 the New York BASS Chapter Federation and the Cpl Kyle Schneider Foundation will co-sponsor and host the sixth annual Take a Soldier Fishing Day. This is an opportunity for anglers to provide a recreational fishing opportunity to active duty military personnel. We pair two military folks with a volunteer boater to fish for 5 hours on Oneida Lake. In 2013, we had over 160 military participants and 85 volunteer boaters.

When the anglers return, we weigh fish for prizes and provide everyone with a picnic meal followed by an awards ceremony and raffle prizes. Our plans for 2014 are bigger than ever and we are partnering with numerous competitive Bar-B-Que teams planning to cook for the soldiers and volunteers.

The Bar-B-Que teams will be travelling from all over New York State to compete and cook and are providing their services for free. Financial donations are being graciously accepted to cover expenses for the meat and side dishes that they will be preparing.

Donations received prior to April 4th will be recognized on a special sponsor banner as well as in our press releases.
