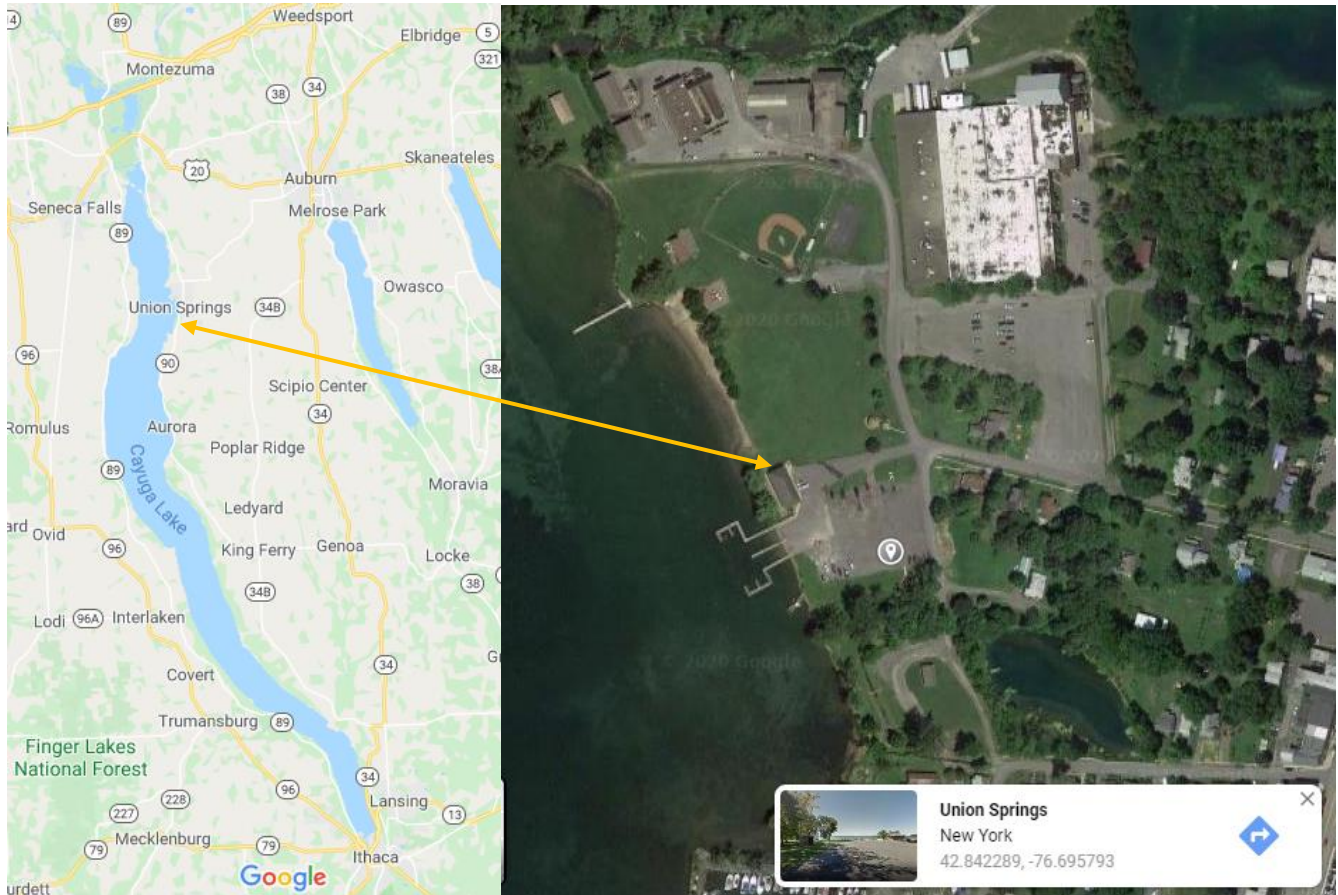




Cayuga Lake Points Tournament September 20th, 2020

(5) Fish limit of Largemouth or Smallmouth bass 12" minimum length.

All Anglers must possess a fizz kit and understand how to use it, should your catch require fizzing.

All Boaters must follow Clean, Drain and Dry Law for official practice and tournament day. No debris on boat/trailer, empty live wells with plugs pulled, bilge plug pulled, and outboard engine should be cleared of any water.

Official practice period will close at 3 p.m. on the day prior to the tournament; Saturday, September 19th, 2020. All contestants must be off the water by this time. It is the responsibility of the contestant to know and observe these dates and times.

All anglers must read and know all tournament rules.

Marinas posted no fishing and within 100 yards of the launch are off limits. Please be respectful of Marina traffic at their entrances.

No locking out of Cayuga Lake/Seneca River. A line from the Mud Lock launch straight across to the West shore is out of bounds. No fishing, casting or boating north of that boundary.

Safety first:

Observe and follow the laws going through no wake zones. This will be closely observed in the Harbor at send off and check in

Each competitor is required to wear a Coast Guard approved chest-type life preserver. The preserver must be snapped, strapped or zipped securely and maintained in that condition any time the combustion engine is running.

Passenger must be seated when combustion engine is running.

If you are wearing an inflatable life vest, you must have a regular non inflatable life vest on board in order to remove the inflatable while fishing. This is a coast guard regulation.

If it is determined that a single boater will be going out alone, that boater must wear their life vest during the entire tournament and check in with the Tournament Director between 11-11:30am to report that they are safe.

Tournament waters may also be restricted at any time because of bad weather.

The Tournament Director always has the right to require the use of running lights, and the authority to delay or cancel the start of an official tournament day because of bad weather or other factors that would endanger the safety of the competitors.
