2022 B.A.S.S. Northeast Regional Championship**

All anglers on the team and the club must be members in good standing and meet all the guidelines of the New York B.A.S.S. Chapter Federation in the qualifying year, on or before September 1st of the qualifying year, as well as the CTC Tournament year.

Each team angler will be fishing for a 5-fish limit for their individual weight for each tournament day. The club team total weight will be the sum of each team members individual weight over the two tournament days of fishing.

The re-registration meeting for the CTC will take place on Friday July 16th, 2021

Other good information:

- All Anglers must possess a fizz kit and understand how to use it should your catch require fizzing
- All Boaters must follow Clean, Drain and Dry Law for official practice and tournament day. No debris on boat / trailer, empty live wells with plugs pulled, bilge plug pulled, and outboard engine should be cleared of any water
- Official practice period will close at 3 p.m. on the day prior to the tournament. All contestants must be off the water by this time. It is the responsibility of the contestant to know and observe these dates and times
- All anglers must read and know all tournament rules. Tournament rules can be found at www.nybassfed.com

Safety first:

- Observe and follow the laws going through no wake zones. This will be closely observed in the harbor at send off and at check in
- Each competitor is required to wear a Coast Guard approved chest-type life preserver. The preserver must be snapped, strapped, or zipped securely and maintained in that condition any time the combustion engine is running.
- If you are wearing an inflatable life vest, you must have a regular non inflatable life vest on board in order to remove the inflatable while fishing. This is a coast guard regulation.
- The Tournament Director always has the right to require the use of running lights, and the authority to delay or cancel the start of an official tournament day because of bad weather or other factors that would endanger the safety of the competitors.
